

This project is formed around three main focal points which are dominant, both functionally and visually. On master plan they occupy the space in the form of triangle in the center of which the hotel is placed.





This design is marked by the complex system of superimposed communications which connect all the main facilities in the space, and are ended by the link with the hotel, from which one arm leads to summer stage.

The concept clearly divides the natural from the artificial, trying to preserve the values of both. The layers of different time periods of the built are recognized, and the greenery is isolated as particular value. The hotel is cascading over the slope towards the wood and with its design it is striving to fit in with the summer stage but also to complete the natural scenery.
